

## An Objective Analysis of the Destruction of the Australian Ethny

The table shows the Australian ethny's population with a small increase in the late nineteenth century and a gradual diminishing since the mid-20th century to the most recent count. Australia enumerated its population by race between 1911-1966, racial-origin in 1971 and 1976, and by self-declared ancestry since 1986.[44]

Australia is overwhelmingly of British origin with 99.3% of the population declaring their race as European in 1947.[35] As of 2016, the majority of Australian ethnics are of English 36.1%, Irish 11.0%, Scottish 9.3%, Italian 4.6%, German 4.5% and Dutch 1.6%. A large proportion —33.5%— chose to identify solely with their 'Australian Ethny'.[45][46][47]

Australia's census conveniently no longer asks for racial background, thus it is unclear exactly how many Australian Citizens today are of the national, ethnical and racial group, the Australian ethny.[44] Figures from 2016 show that the Australian ethny made up only 76% of the overall Australian Population at that time.[42][43]

With the Australian Government's census data, we can easily track through time the physical destruction, of the national, ethnical and racial group, the Australian ethny.[33][36][38][42][43] The objectively measurable genetic loss incurred by a member of the Australian ethny, when random fellow ethnics are replaced by immigrants from different ethnies, is a destructive action and measure which has been proven to prevent births within the Australian ethny. The genetic losses incurred via damage to the reproductive fitness of members of the Australian ethny, by way of loss of monopoly of a demarcated territory, are thus scientifically verifiable acts of genocide under the provision of international law.
